## SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES

Kianinny has invested in hundreds of solar panels to provide clean electricity to all of our Accommodation options onsite. We plan to increase this even further in the near future.

We compost all our organic waste through the Bega Valley FOGO system & teach the students about the importance of this & limiting food waste while on camp.

For toilet paper, tissues and other paper products we source 100% recycled & ethical goods from 'Who Gives a Crap', who donate 50% of profits to build toilets in the developing world. With over 3,700 students coming through our doors in 2023, we're thrilled to know we are making significant contribution to this cause.

## LOOKING AFTER OUR ENVIRONMENT

With 100 acres of private bushland to play in, it is important that we tread lightly, and pass on to our students a culture of respect and honour for the plants, animals, birds and landforms we share space with.

Kianinny is home to many vulnerable and endangered species, such as the Glossy Black Cockatoo, Yellow-bellied Glider and Swift Parrot, and we often have wildlife enthusiasts travel to us to spend time with the many animals that live here.
